



# 4 Free Lessons Explained

Q. "You said we receive 4 free lessons per year. I'm still confused."

A. These free lessons are actually EXTRA lessons you receive throughout the year that we could charge you for, but we don't. We consider them preemptive make-up lessons, so that if your day fell on one of the major holidays that we are closed like Independence Day, or if you have to cancel a lesson at any given time, it's already made up. **Let's take a look as though your lesson day was on a Tuesday...**

As you can see March 2022 has FIVE Tuesdays in it.

So, throughout the year, you get **four** EXTRA lessons at no charge.

Those extra lessons are used for **any day** during the year that you cancel the lesson or if your day lands on one of the **Holidays** listed below.

So don't worry, a 4-week month with only 3 lessons given that month, is made up by a 5-week month!

If you have more than one instrument being taught, just add four extra lessons per instrument. For example, a household with 2 (instruments) will equal 8 extra lessons per year. **Whatever you don't use will be to your benefit!**

**Holidays Closed:** New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas
