



4 Free Lessons Explained

Q. “You said we receive 4 free lessons per year. I’m still confused.”

A. These free lessons are actually EXTRA lessons you receive throughout the year that we could charge you for, but we don’t. We consider them preemptive make-up lessons, so that if your day (say it was Thursday) fell on one of the six major holidays (like 4th of July), or if you have to cancel a lesson at any given time, it’s already made up. **Let’s take a look...**

As you can see January 2019 has FIVE Thursdays in it.

Those extra lessons are used for holidays like 4th of July, or any day that you cancel the lesson.

So don’t worry, a 4-week month with only 3 lessons given that month, is made up by a 5-week month!

If you have more than one instrument being taught, just add four extra lessons per instrument. For example, a household with 2 (instruments) will equal 8 extra lessons per year. Whatever you don’t use will be to your benefit!
